Jesus: "...light of the world..."

First of three similar paintings by William Holman Hunt (1827–1910), now in the side chapel at Keble College, Oxford. A second, smaller version of the work, painted by Hunt between 1851 and 1856, is on display at Manchester City Art Gallery, which purchased it in 1912. Hunt was persuaded to paint a larger, life-sized version. He began it in about 1900 and finished in 1904. Charles Booth purchased the work and it was hung in St Paul's Cathedral, London.
