42:3 a bruised reed he will not break, and a dimly burning wick he will not quench; he will faithfully bring forth justice.

42:4 He will not grow faint or be crushed until he has established justice in the earth, and the coastlands wait for his teaching.

A Reading from Acts 10:34-43

he is Lord of all.

10:37 That message spread throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John

10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went
about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

10:39 We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. They put him to death
by hanging him on a tree,

10:40 but God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear,

10:41 not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses and who ate and
drank with him after he rose from the dead.

10:42 He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by
God as judge of the living and the dead.

10:43 All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness
of sins through his name."
