Synod is Coming Soon!!

As you likely already know, the Diocese of Edmonton will be holding a Synod on October 23-24, 2026. If you are a member of clergy or a lay member elected as a parish delegate and you have not yet registered for Synod, please take a moment to do so. All delegates are required to **register** by September 15, 2026 online using one of the links below:

- **Clergy Registration**
- **Lay Registration** - A completed **Certificate of Election** is required for all elected lay delegates to register, signed by your incumbent. *If you do not have an incumbent, please complete the certification section and attached the unsigned form to your registration.*

We are also seeking **nominations** for positions on Executive Council, delegates to General Synod (in 2028), delegates to Provincial Synod (in 2027), the Court of the Synod of the Diocese of Edmonton, and Clerical and Lay Recorders for the 71st Synod (in 2028). Nominees must be delegates at the 2026 Synod. A description of Elected Positions, the Guidelines for Nominations, and a link to the online Nomination Form are posted below. The deadline for nominations is September 9, 2026.
